Statement:

“An important factor which should be born in mind when looking at my pictures is that I draw and paint directly from nature. I don't usually work within the confines of the Studio. This choice has been made because the Imagination, which must be the central guiding force for artists, is for me best awakened through the senses. When I am confronting nature with my paints and drawing materials I am made immediately aware of the dynamic force of my sensory field. I try to catch these responses and give them visual expression before they vanish. If the Imagination has been successfully engaged it will leave a trace within the drawing or painting which needs to be firstly identified and then developed. This emerging element is known as the Form and has central importance because it elevates the merely factual or literal into the metaphorical and therefore endows the picture with resonance and meaning.”
